

HELP FOR THE APPLICATION GAME4U

The Game4U app can be accessed from the main Math4U portal page (math4u.vsb.cz). To access the Game4U app, you will need an access code that you will receive from your teacher. Each game your teacher prepares for you will have a different access code.



The student enters their name or nickname (as required by the teacher) and the access code. The code must be entered exactly, including upper and lower case letters. After logging in, the student will see the name and rules of the game, as shown in the following images:

Game Triangle

Game type: Triangle

Game rules:

The goal of the game is to connect all three sides of the displayed triangle with a continuous path. Each player chooses a tile they want to claim. After clicking on the selected tile, a question appears, which the player must answer correctly to claim the tile. If the player answers incorrectly, the opponent gets a chance to answer the same question, but may choose not to. If the opponent also answers incorrectly or decides not to answer, the tile remains neutral. If a player wants to claim a neutral tile, they must press the button during the draw phase when the displayed symbols match. Otherwise, the tile goes to the opponent.

Game rules:

The goal of the game is to uncover the image. Each tile is revealed by correctly answering prepared questions. You can answer the questions by clicking on the tile.

The Game4U application will only function properly if automatic translation is disabled in your browser. Please check this and turn off automatic translation if necessary.

Turn off automatic translation in Google Chrome

1. Open Google Chrome.
2. Click on the three dots icon (Menu) in the top right corner and select **Settings**.
3. Click on **Languages** in the left menu.
4. In the **Google Translate** section, find the **Use Google Translate** option and uncheck it.
5. If you want, you can also manage the languages for which translation should start automatically or which should not be translated.

Turn off automatic translation in Microsoft Edge

1. Open Microsoft Edge.
2. Click on the three dots in the top right corner and select **Settings**.
3. Select **Languages**.
4. In the **Offer to translate pages that aren't in a language I read** section, turn off the option to automatically offer translation or set the languages for which translation is not provided.

Turn off automatic translation in Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox.
2. If a translation panel appears when you open a foreign language page, click on its icon.
3. In the translator settings, you can turn off automatic translation or disable the translation offer for a given language.

The above will ensure that automatic translation does not interfere with the functionality of the Game4U application or distort the content.
